

STANDING ORDER  
NO. 4 /2002

Subject: - Criteria for consideration of cases of police personnel for out of turn promotion under sports quota provided under Rule 13.1 of Punjab Police Rules.

This Standing Order supersedes all the previous Standing Orders/guidelines on the subject cited above.

The main object of this Standing Order is to lay down the criteria and procedure to consider cases of police personnel for promotion under 5% sports quota as provided under PPR 13.1 to recognize their achievements in the field of sports at National/International level if they are otherwise eligible for promotion but for seniority.

Every year in the first week of January, a circular will be issued by the office to all GOs to forward applications of outstanding sports persons along with photocopy of their achievements in the sports field, who are covered under the criteria laid down in this Standing Order for promotion under sports quota. The last date for the receipt of applications would be 31<sup>st</sup> of January. The applications so received would be scrutinized by the office and put before the Sports Promotion Committee

constituted under this Standing Order by the Inspector General of Police. The committee will be constituted every year in the first week of February each year and its meeting will be convened in the second week of February.

**CRITERIA:**

The following sports events will be considered for the purpose of this Standing Order:

1. Athletics
2. Basket Ball
3. Foot Ball
4. Hockey
5. Judo
6. Kabaddi
7. Volley Ball
8. Wrestling
9. Gymnastics
10. Handball
11. Aquatic Meet & Cross Country Race
12. Weightlifting
13. Boxing
14. Equestrian
15. Shooting(events recognized only in National Games)

The Inspector General of Police will be competent to add or delete any sports event.

**PROMOTION FROM SUB-INSPECTOR TO INSPECTOR**

A Sub-Inspector will be eligible for consideration for promotion to the rank of Inspector if:

**INDIVIDUAL PERFORMANCE**

1. he qualifies for the final round in Olympics, or
2. he wins a medal in the Commonwealth/Asian Games, or
3. he wins three gold medals in the National Games.

#### **TEAM EVENTS**

1. The team he is representing (and also plays) wins any medal in Olympics/Common Wealth/Asian Games or the team he is representing wins three times gold medal in the National Games.

#### **PROMOTION FROM ASI TO SI AND HC TO ASI**

An ASI and HC will be eligible for consideration for promotion to ASI and SI respectively if:

#### **INDIVIDUAL ACHIEVEMENT**

1. he is having achievements as mentioned above for promotion from the rank of SI to the rank of Inspector, or
2. he wins three gold medals in All India Police Games, or
3. two gold medal in National Games.

#### **TEAM EVENTS**

1. If he is having achievement as mentioned in the case of promotion from the rank of

- SI to the rank of Inspector mentioned above, or
2. he is selected to represent the country in team events in Olympic/Asian/Commonwealth Games, or
  3. the team he is representing wins twice gold medals in National Games, or
  4. the team he is representing wins thrice gold medals in All India Police Games.

FOR PROMOTION FROM CONSTABLE TO HEAD CONSTABLE.


A constable will be eligible for consideration for promotion to the rank of HC if

1. he is having any achievements as mentioned above for promotion to ranks of ASI/SI and Inspector, or
2. he wins a silver medal in national games or
3. he wins a gold medal in All India Police Games, or
4. he wins three silver medals in All India Police Games.

In case an official is once promoted under sports quota, for next promotion his achievements after the date of earlier promotion will be considered.

The police personnel who will fulfill the above said criteria for consideration for promotion under sports quota will be further eligible for promotion to the next rank only if they are otherwise found eligible/qualified for

promotion to that rank (i.e. qualifying the training course/minimum required length of service etc.) as per the rule/instructions but for seniority. In other words if they are not eligible/qualified for the next higher post for which they are being considered, they will not be fit for promotion under the sports quota. At the time of consideration of their cases other eligibility condition such as their work and conduct and service record will also be kept in view as is being done in the case of other promotion cases. The promotion under sports quota would not mean promotion in the inter-se-seniority and as such inter-se-seniority of the promotee in the cadre will not be disturbed as a result of promotion under sports quota. The applicants will be entitled to promotion under sports quota, if otherwise found fit by the Sports Promotion Committee, subject to availability of vacancies.
