

# STANDING ORDER

## No. 29 /2004

**Subject:- Criteria for consideration of cases of police personnel for out of turn promotion under sports quota provided under Rule 13.1 of Punjab Police rules.**

This Standing order supersedes all the previous Standing Orders/guidelines on the subject cited above.

The main object of this Standing Order is to lay down the criteria and procedure to consider cases of police personnel for promotion under 5% sport quota as provided under PPR 13.1 to recognize their achievements in the field of sports at National/International level if they are otherwise eligible for promotion but for seniority.

Every year in the first week of January, a circular will be issued by the office to all GOs to forward applications of outstanding sports persons along with photocopy of their achievements in the sports field, who are covered under the criteria laid down in this Standing Order for promotion under sports quota. The last date for the receipt of applications would be 31<sup>st</sup> of January. The applications so received would be scrutinized by the office and put before the Sports Promotion Committee constituted under this Standing Order by the Inspector General of Police. The Committee will be constituted every year in the first week of February and its meeting will be convened in the second week of February.

### CRITERIA:

The following sports events will be considered for the purpose of this Standing Order:-

1. Athletics
2. Basket Ball]
3. Foot Ball
4. Hockey

5. Judo
6. Kabaddi
7. Volley Ball
8. Wrestling
9. Gymnastics
10. Handball
11. Aquatic Meet & Cross Country Race
12. Weightlifting
13. Boxing
14. Equestrian
15. Shooting (events recognized only in National Games)

The Inspector General of Police will be competent to add or delete any sports event.

#### PROMOTION FROM SUB-INSPECTOR TO INSPECTOR

A Sub-Inspector will be eligible for consideration for promotion to the rank of Inspector under sports quota if :-

##### INDIVIDUAL PERFORMANCE

1. he qualifies for the final round for Olympics, or
2. he wins a medal in the Commonwealth/Asian Games, or
3. he wins three gold medals in the National Games.

##### TEAM EVENTS

The team he is representing (and also plays) wins any medal in Olympics/Common Wealth/Asian Games or the team he is representing wins three times gold medal in the National Games.

#### PROMOTION FROM ASI TO SI AND HC TO ASI

An ASI and HC will be eligible for consideration for promotion to the rank of SI and ASI respectively if :-

##### INDIVIDUAL ACHIEVEMENT

1. he is having achievements as mentioned above for promotion from the rank of SI to Inspector, or
2. he wins three gold medals in All India Police Games, or
3. Two gold medals in National Games.

### TEAM EVENTS

1. if he is having achievement as mentioned in the case of promotion from the rank of SI to the rank of Inspector mentioned above, or
2. he is selected to represent the country in team events in Olympic/Asian/Common Wealth Games, or
3. the team he is representing wins twice gold medal in national Games, or
4. the team he is representing wins thrice gold medal in All India Police Games.

### FOR PROMOTION FROM CONSTQABLE TO HEAD CONSTABLE


A Constable will be eligible for consideration for promotion to the rank of HC if :-

1. he is having any achievements as mentioned above for promotion to ranks of ASI/SI and Inspector, or
2. he wins a silver medal in National Games, or
3. he wins a gold medal in All India Police Games, or
4. he wins three silver medals in All India Police Games.

In case an official is once promoted under sports quota, for next promotion his achievements after the date of earlier promotion will be considered.

The Police personnel who fulfill the above said criteria for consideration for promotion under sports quota will be further eligible for promotion to the next rank purely on adhoc basis provided they otherwise fulfill the eligibility conditions for promotion to that rank. The promotion under sports quota would not mean promotion in the inter-se seniority and as such inter-se-seniority of the promotee in the cadre will not be disturbed as a result of adhoc promotion under sports quota. In case the official does not fulfill the eligibility conditions such

as minimum qualifying service/qualifying the training course, he will be given ORP rank till he fulfill eligibility conditions for adhoc promotion. The adhoc promotion/ORP rank granted as per provisions of this Standing Order under Sports Quota would be liable to be withdrawn at any time without issuing any notice in case the performance of the official is found not satisfactory at a later stage or he is awarded a major punishment in due course after promotion.
