ENSURE THE FOLLOWING

1. Installation/use of iron grills on windows etc.
2. Secure bolting of doors & Windows.
3. Installation/use of additional locks particularly, floor locks.
4. Doors chains and magic eyes.
5. Install Anti-burglar alarm. .
6. Entrance, doors not to be kept unattended.
7. Strangers not to be permitted entry into the house.
8. Verification of servants.
9. Employing foreigners as domestic help to be avoided.
10. Valuable articles including cash and Jewelry to be kept in Lockers & safe.
11. Record of all your valuables and their insurance.
12. Inform about suspicious persons in the neighborhood to the Police Control Room Phone 100 or nearest Police Station.

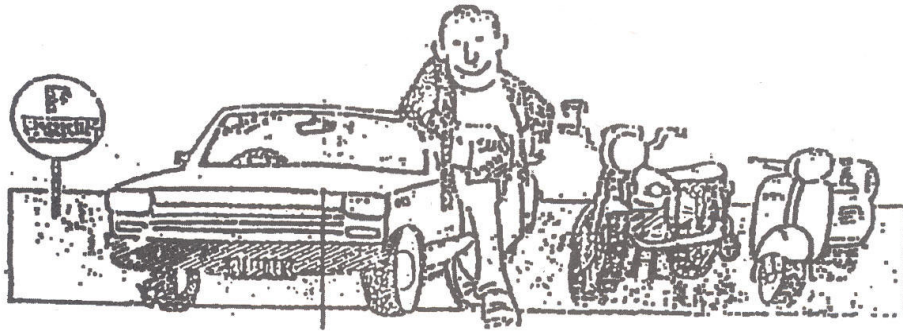
SOME BASIC PRECAUTIONS: -

1. All windows etc. should have iron grills.
2. Doors/windows should be securely bolted.
3. Door chains and magic eyes should be installed and should be installed and used.
4. Servants should be got verified.
5. Valuables should be kept in theft-proof lockers & safes.
6. Property should be got insured.
7. Neighbors should be alerted if you are leaving the house un-attended.
8. Entrance doors should not be kept open when un-attended.
9. Be cautious of strangers seeking entry into your house.
10. Pass on information about suspicious persons in the neighborhood to the Police Control Room.

ENSURE THE FOLLOWING

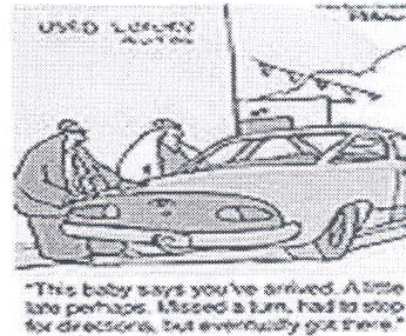
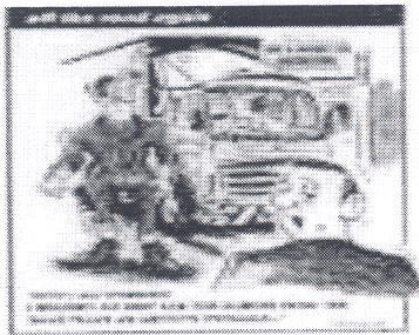
1. Insurance.
2. Etching of registration no. of the Vehicle on its front and rear glass panes.
3. Steering locks and security alarm (for cars).
4. Safety clamps (for two wheelers).
5. No. Valuable articles including cash & jewelry by kept unattended in the vehicle.
6. Parking at authorized place. (Where available) and inside your premises.
7. Information about suspicious persons in the neighborhood to the Police Control Room Phone No. 100 or nearest Police Station be passed.

LEVEL OF PROTECTION RECOMMENDED FOR YOUR VEHICLE AND LOCATION

FIRST LAYER	An unlocked vehicle with a key in the ignition is an open invitation to any thief, regardless of which anti-theft device you use. The common sense approach to protection is the simplest and most cost-effective way to thwart would-be thieves.
SECOND LAYER	A visible or audible device alerts thieves that your vehicle is protected before they attempt to steal it. According to a recent study by the NICB, users of steering wheel locks were four times less likely to become a vehicle theft victim than the average motorists. Some second layer devices are also effective in protecting your vehicle from burglary and vandalism. WATCH YOUR CAR decals are a second layer-warning device.
THIRD LAYER	Electronic immobilizing devices prevent thieves from bypassing your ignition and hot wiring the vehicle. Some devices have computer chips in ignition keys. Other manual devices inhibit the flow of electricity or fuel to the engine until a hidden switch is activated. A third category passively immobilizes the vehicle by interrupting the starter, ignition and fuel.
FOURTH LAYER	A tracking system emits a signal to police or monitoring service when the vehicle is reported stolen. Tracking systems are very effective in helping authorities recover stolen vehicles.

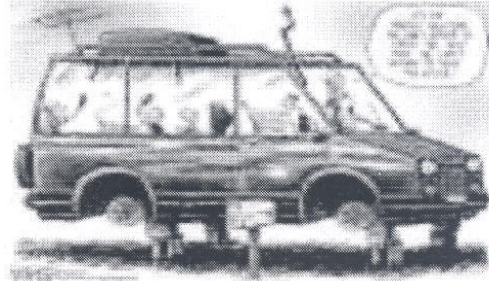
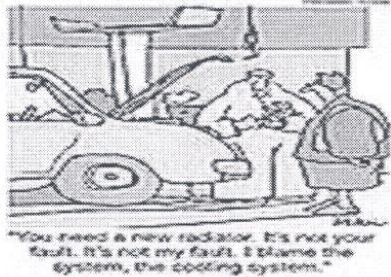

Secure your vehicle



You can prevent Auto Theft by taking certain precautions

- Park your vehicle at right place
- Use Central Lock and Alarm
- Get registration number etched on window - panes.
- Don't keep your valuables in the car while parking.

Precautionary Steps Against Vehicle Thefts

1. Always lock your car, and remove your keys from the ignition.
2. Install an anti-theft device that is highly visible, hard to defeat, and that renders the vehicle un-drivable.
3. Park in a garage when possible or choose a well-lighted, heavily traveled area to park.
4. When parking curb - side, turn your vehicle's wheels sharply toward the curb and apply the emergency brake.
5. Do not hide spare keys on the vehicle.
6. Etch your vehicle identification number on car windows and major parts. This procedure makes vehicles and parts more easily traceable when stolen.
7. Engrave your drivers license number on stereos and car phones.
8. If any person is found selling/offering car for sale at throw - away price, Immediately inform the police.
9. In case any Motor Vehicle theft immediately inform to the Police Control Room on Phone No.100 or 2742655.
