

**Terms and Condition
for the purchase of CBRN protective Equipments/articles for
Chandigarh Police**

1. The tenders/quotations in a sealed cover marked in bold letters "**TENDER FOR THE SUPPLY OF CBRN protective Equipments/articles**" must reach in the office of the Inspector General of Police, UT Sector-9, Chandigarh on or before _____ at 11.00 A.M.
2. No conditional/optional tender/quotation shall be accepted and Bidders shall not be permitted to alter or modify their bids after expiry of the deadline for receipt of Bids.
3. Bidders must submit an affidavit to the effect that the firm is neither blacklisted by any Government Department nor any Criminal Case is registered against the firm or its owner or partners or directors anywhere in India. The firms blacklisted by any Govt. Department, shall not be considered for these Quotations.
4. The tender/quotation must be accompanied with tender/quotation fee amounting to Rs.500/- for each item in the form of Account Payee Demand Draft, Banker's Cheque from any of the financial banks in an acceptable form in favor of the **Inspector General of Police, U.T. Chandigarh.** Failure to do so will result in the rejection of tender/quotation.
5. The successful bidder will submit the following amount as Security as mentioned below against each equipment/article in the form of Account Payee Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt, Banker's Cheque or Bank Guarantee, from any of the financial banks, in an acceptable form in favor of the **Inspector General of Police, U.T. Chandigarh.** Failure to do so will result in the rejection of supply order. No interest will be payable by the Purchaser on this amount.

6. The bidders should have their firm registered with the Sales Tax/VAT Department, with respect to Sales Tax/ VAT and shall furnish copies of the same with their Technical Bid.
7. The qualifying criteria of CBRN equipment/article is inspection report of Technical Expert of DRDO Laboratory Gwalior/ DRDO Laboratory Jodhpur.
8. The Bidder shall indicate the Price of equipment as mentioned item wise/ unit price including tax/VAT and AMC Charges per Annum.
9. AMC is to be considered as a loading factor and would be considered as a criterion for deciding the lowest bidder for the entire Equipment. No hidden cost will be accepted.
10. Delivery and installation of the equipment at locations to be finalized by Chandigarh Police shall be completed by the Supplier in accordance with the terms specified by the Purchaser within 42 days (6 weeks) from the date of Award of Contract. If any document is required by the vender from Chandigarh Police to complete the supply, the same must be obtained within the supply

period mentioned above and supply of equipment/article must be completed within stipulated period.

11. The Equipment will be accepted after inspection by purchase committee with the help of technical expert from DRDO Laboratory Gwalior/ DRDO Laboratory Jodhpur. Thereafter payment will be released in favour of supplier. No advance payment shall be made.
12. The equipment/article to be quoted by the bidder should carry 1 (one) year comprehensive on site warranty. The Warranty will start from the date of supply of the equipment and acceptance by the Department. The Bidder have to provide 2 years maintenance for the following equipment after the expiry of 1 (one) year warranty period for which bidder have to quote the AMC Charges per year separately in the quotation.
 - a) Residual Vapour Detector kit (Detector Tube)
 - b) Leak Tester for Mask
 - c) Autoject Injector (Reusable) (AJ-I)
 - d) Personal decontamination kit
 - e) Radiometer Personal Locket (RPL) Dosimeter (Watch Type)
 - f) Radiometer Personal Locket (RPL) Dosimeter Reader
 - g) Pocket Dosimeter (PDM)
 - h) Portable Dose Rate Meter (PDRM)
 - i) Telescopic Gamma Survey Meter
 - j) Micro R Gamma Survey Meter
 - k) Gamma Survey Meter
 - l) Alfa Contamination Monitor
 - m) Beta and Gamma Contamination Monitor
 - n) Micro Radiation Survey Meter
 - o) Alscin Wall Monitor
 - p) Radiation Survey Meter
13. The Supplier shall quote the rates for comprehensive annual Maintenance of the equipments in the Price Schedule quotation for next 02 years after expiry of the warranty/guarantee period of 01 (One) year.
14. During the term of warranty/guarantee/AMC the service/repair calls will have to be attended by the Supplier within 72 hours from the time of such calls and rectify the problem maximum within 96 hours including replacement/repair of defective equipment. Beyond this the firm is liable for penalty as per term & condition. The defective item/equipment should be repaired on the same day at Purchaser's location. In case of major defects requiring the defective card/item/equipment to be taken to the Supplier's workshop, it should be returned within a week duly repaired and an immediate substitute card/item/equipment will be provided by the Supplier for the smooth operation of the System. The to and fro transportation of the card/item/equipment will be the responsibility of Supplier.

15. If the Supplier fails to repair or replace the defective Equipment/Item, the Purchaser will be free to get the same repaired/replaced from the market and its cost will be adjusted from the Supplier's Contract Performance Security and repaired failure by the Vendor in attending the complaint will attract penalties.
16. Delays in attending the calls and or repairing the defective equipment beyond time limit given in this Clause, without providing the substitute, will attract penalties. AMC charges of the delayed period will not be paid if the delay is more than one week from the specified time limit on pro-rata basis.
17. The Bidder shall undertake to train the staff nominated by Chandigarh Police twice in a year during warranty period in different aspects of equipments functioning, testing, operation, maintenance and trouble shooting.
18. If the bidder fails to supply the material within the stipulated period, the Purchaser reserves the right to impose penalty equivalent to 1 (one) percent of the price for delay in unperformed service for each & every week (part of a week being treated as a full week) of delay until actual delivery of material up to a maximum deduction of 05% (Five Percent) and also blacklist the company.
19. **Termination for Default :-** The Purchaser may without prejudice to any other remedy for breach of Contract, by Thirty (30) days written notice of default sent to the Supplier and upon the Supplier's failure and neglect to propose and/or execute any corrective action to cure the default, terminate this Contract in whole or in part:
 - (i) If the Supplier fails to deliver equipment required as defined in Condition no 10 within the time period(s) specified in the Contract ;or
 - (ii) If the Supplier fails to perform any other obligation (s) under the Contract.On termination of the Contract for default, the security deposit of the Supplier will be forfeited.
20. The Bidder will undertake that supplies of necessary maintenance equipment and Sufficient spares should be available in stock with the supplier and certificate for availability of spares in Chandigarh for at least life of the equipment/article after one (1) year warranty period and 2 Years AMC period specified in technical specifications and there shall be no hidden cost.

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
